Ambrogio Pozzi was an important Italian 20th century designer, working in ceramic, glass, plastic, and metals. He collaborated with prominent designers of his time including, Gio Ponti, Pierre Cardin and Joe Columbo. He was good friends with the important Finnish designer Tapio Wirkkala.
